- 2. FOLLOWING DRAFTED BY POLOFF BENTLEY IN ARUSHA MIDDAY NOVEMBER 25.
- 3. WORD OF A BREAKTHROUGH IN KIGALI ON THE TRANSITIONAL NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ENABLED GOR FOREIGN MINISTER NGULINZIRA TO ANNOUNCE THAT HIS DELEGATION WAS PREPARED TO TAKE UP THE OUTSTANDING ISSUES ON THE POLITICAL AGENDA IN NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE RPF. THE RPF HAS AGREED, AND, DESPITE SOME CONTENTIOUS LANGUAGE IN THE

PLENARY ON NOVEMBER 25, TALKS ARE BEGINNING ON THE ISSUES OF THE COMPOSITION OF THE TRANSITIONAL CABINET AND THE TRANSITIONAL NATIONAL ASSEMBLY.

- 4. FOREIGN MINISTER NGULINZIRA INFORMED THE PLENARY THAT HIS GOVERNMENT ACCEPTED THE PRINCIPLE OF AN APPOINTED TRANSITIONAL ASSEMBLY. HE ALSO PROPOSED A MEETING BETWEEN THE POLITICAL PARTIES IN THE CURRENT COALITION GOVERNMENT AND THE RPF TO DISCUSS THE ALLOCATION OF CABINET PORTFOLIOS, TO BE HOSTED BY THE TANZANIANS, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE RPF-GOR NEGOTIATIONS. THE RPF INDICATED ITS WILLINGNESS TO TAKE UP THE POLITICAL AGENDA BUT REJECTED THE MEETING WITH POLITICAL PARTIES. IT SUGGESTED THAT THE GOR COULD INCLUDE THE PARTIES IN ITS NEGOTIATING TEAM, AND SAID THE GOR SUGGESTION DEMONSTRATED THAT THE GOR TEAM DID NOT REPRESENT THE FORCES IN THE COALITION CABINET.
