

Bonn freezes aid for Rwanda

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BONN, April 11 (AFP) - Germany has decided to freeze 83 million marks (49 million dollars) in planned development aid for Rwanda in the light of developments in that strife-torn country, the Economic Cooperation Ministry said here on Monday.

Spranger said cooperation was currently out of the question because of fighting.

The aid, promised at the end of 1993, relates primarily to agriculture, infrastructure work, health and education.
