1. During the past 24 hours the following incidents are significant:
 - a. Displaced Persons. An attempt was made to evacuate 60 Rwandese from the Mille Collines. These people possessed visas from foreign embassies. Agreement was received from the Chief of Staff of the RGF. Convoy was stopped by militia. Rwandese were pulled off the vehicles and some were beaten. Government agreement appeared not to matter to local militia leader. Negotiation was successful in avoiding bloodshed. After some two hours UN MTR in conjunction with Prefect of Kigali succeeded in having displaced persons returned to the Mille Collines but only after they had been voted.
 - b. Humanitarian Assistance. UNMO patrols continued with escorts for relief agencies and verification of displaced persons camps in Kigali.
 - c. Evacuation of ex-patriates. NTR.
 - d. Miscellaneous. NTR.
