DRAFT-1 OF STANDING OPERATING PROCEDURE FOR
ESTABLISHMENT OF CEASEFIRE IN RWANDA

Reference: 3000.5(FC) 05/06, Kigali, 14 May 1994.

As you are aware, UNAMIR staff met with the Rwandese Government Forces on 16 May to discuss the first draft of a Standard Operating Procedure for Establishment of a Ceasefire in Rwanda. As of this date we have not received any comments from your High Command staff. Your Liaison Officer to my Headquarters indicated verbally, that no action will be taken on the subject by your staff until the two conditions are met.

Such a major shift of attitude towards a staff activity that we had previously agreed to conduct is most disconcerting. Should you so desire, it is our hope that a meeting between your staff and the UNAMIR staff at a time and place of your choosing to discuss this important document may still be able to take place.
