AS OF 13:00 EDT, April 7, 1994 Rwanda/Burundi: Violence Update, No. 2

--Army Headquarters reports that the Presidential Guard is "out of control" on the streets of Kigali while all other military units remain in their barracks, according to the US Defense attache in Kigali. He sees no effort by other military units to stop the presidential guard.

Earlier twelve peacekeepers that had been guarding the assassinated Prime Minister Agathe Uwilingiyamana were disarmed and led away by Rwandan troops.
