(a) REFERENCE OUR SITREP COVERING PERIOD 021600Z DEC TO 031600Z DEC ABOUT THE 5 DEAD CHILDREN FOUND IN THE FOREST, INVESTIGATION REVEALED THAT THE GIRLS WERE RAPED AND 5 OF THEM WERE CHOKED TO DEATH. MULTIPLE INJURIES WERE FOUND ON THE THEIR PERSONS. THE 6TH VICTIM WAS RUSHED TO THE RUHENGERI HOSPITAL IN A COMA AND KEPT UNDER UN GUARD. SHE DIED LAST NIGHT OF HER WOUNDS.

(b) 11 STUDENTS DIED IN AN EXPLOSION OF A BOOBY TRAP IN GITARAMA (SOUTH OF KIGALI). DETAILS ARE BEING INVESTIGATED.

(a) IN THE MORNING OF 04 DEC, 6 MEMBERS OF UN TUNISIAN PL WHILE PATROLLING THE SAME TRAILS WEST OF RUHENGERI IN ORDER TO RETRIEVE THE BODIES OF THE CHILDREN WITH THE PARENTS AND ALSO TO INVESTIGATE ALTERNATE ROUTES USED BY THE PERPETRATORS OF THE KILLINGS ON THE NIGHT 29/30 NOV ENCOUNTERED A MINE ON THE SAME TRAIL USED PREVIOUSLY BY THE FC ON THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION PATROL. ONE CIVILIAN WAS INJURED. BELGIAN EOD TEAM SENT TO THE AREA TO INVESTIGATE BUT LACKS TECHNICAL EQUIPMENT. UNMOS ARE INVESTIGATING THE INCIDENT. WE HAVE HALTED THE INVESTIGATIVE
