- SITUATION STILL TENSE THOUGH RELATIVELY CALM. NO SIGNIFICANT CAHNGES IN FORWARD EDGE OF BATTLE AREA UP NORTH BYUMBA BELIEVED TO BE UNDER RPF CONTROL SPORADIC EXCHANGES OF FIRE IN KIGALI OVER THE PERIOD. TO THE NORTH RPF CONSOLIDATING THEIR POSITIONS AROUND MERIDIEN HOTEL TOWARDS HOTEL VILLAGE URUGWIRO. RGF PRESENCE AT GHADDAFI CROSS ROADS DESPITE RPF PRESENCE ON HILLS OVERLOOKING JUNCTION. TO THE EAST RGF STILL CONTROLLING ROAD TO AIRPORT FROM REMERA JUNCTION. TO THE SOUTH RPF CONTROLLING AREA AROUND RWANDEX WITH MILITIA SOME 200 METERS AWAY.
