- THE CENERAL SITUATION REMAINS TENSE AND VOLATILE. RGF AND RPF ARE OBSERVING TRUCE PARTIALLY. EXCHANGE OF ARTY/MORTAR AND SMALL ARMS PIRE CONTINUED BETWEEN ALL SIDES DURING THE PERIOD. AREAS OF EXCHANGES WERE GIKCNDO, KYCHIRU, KIMIHURURA AND THE CITY CENTRE. EXODUS OF RGF TROOPS, CIVILIANS AND MILITIA TO THE SOUTH CONTINUED DURING THE PERIOD. RPF CONTINUES TO PUSH CLOSER AND CLOSER TO THE CITY CENTRE FROM THE HAST AND SOUTHERN PARTS OF THE CITY.
