SITREP COVERING PERIOD 070600B JUNE TO 071800B JUNE 94.

- 1. GEN SITUATION. THERE WAS NO CHANGE IN THE VOLATILITY OF THE OVERALL SITUATION. KIGALI REMAINED TENSE AND THE EXCHANGES OF HEAVY ARTY/MORTAR, HMC AND SAS FIRE CONTINUED ALL DAY IN AND AROUND NYAMIRAMBO, CAMP KIGALI, KYCHIRU, PARTS OF GIKONDO AND KIMIHURURA, FIGHTING WAS HEAVIEST AROUND NYAMIRAMBO WHERE ABOUT THIRTY TWO SHELLS LANDED. IT WAS OBSERVED THAT THE RGF TROOPS DEPLOYED AROUND THE KIYOVU SUBURB HAD BEEN WITHDRAWN. SOME TROOPS AND MILITIAMEN WERE OBSERVED TO BE WEARING FLAK JACKETS IN THE CITY, OUTSIDE THE CITY, HEAVY FIGHTING WAS REPORTED IN AND AROUND SHYORONGI TO THE NORTH OF KIGALI, BASE AND NKUMBA IN THE NORTH AND ON THE OUTSKIRTS OF GITARAMA.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE INTERIM MIN OF TRANSPORT IS QUOTED AS HAVING ACCUSED UGANDA OF PREPARING TO SEND SOME 40,000 MEN INTO RWANDA TO HELP THE RPF. THE POPULATION ARE BEING URGED TO GO OUT AND CONTINUE KILLING THE ENEMY WHO WANT TO TAKEOVER THEIR FATHERLAND. AFRICA WATCH HAS EXPRESSED CONCERN ABOUT HUMAN RIGHT ABUSES BEING CARRIED OUT BY THE RPF AROUND BUGESERA AND OTHER AREAS UNDER RPF CONTROL. THE DAU MINISTERIAL CONFERENCE DISCUSSED THE RWANDAN CRISIS TODAY IN TUNIS.
- 3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES. FIGHTING CONTINUES UNABATED IN THE CITY, IN THE NORTH AND IN THE SOUTH.
 - A. RPF. RPR TROOPS IN THE CITY CONTINUE TO PUT PRESSURE ON RGF POCKETS OF RESISTANCE IN THE CITY CENTER AND THE WESTERN PART OF THE CITY. HEAVILY SHELLED THE AREA OF NYAMIRAMBO WHERE ABOUT 30 SHELLS LANDED DURING THE DAY. THERE WERE REPORTS OF MANY CASUALTIES. ALSO EXCHANGED FIRE WITH THE RGF AND THE REMNANTS OF THE PRESIDENTIAL GUARDS IN KIMIHURURA CAME, KYCHIRU AND CAMP KIGALI. REPORTED TO HAVE OCCUPIED THE MOSQUE IN NYAMIRAMBO. PRESENCE REPORTED ABOUT 2 KMB OUTSIDE GITARAMA. REPORTED TO BE STILL HOLDING AND HARASSING RGF TROOPS IN THE NORTH.
 - B. RGF. CONTINUE TO HOLD FIRM TO AREAS UNDER THEIR CONTROL IN THE CITY DESPITE THE HEAVY BOMBARDMENT BY THE RPF. TROOPS DEFLOYED IN THE KIYOVE SUBURB WERE OBSERVED TO HAVE BEEN WITHDRAWN, SOME TROOPS WERE OBSERVED TO BE WEARING FLAK JACKETS. (THE TYPE USED BY THE BELGIANS). CONTINUED TO CONSOLIDATE THEIR POSITIONS AROUND GITARAMA AND RUHENGERI.
 - C. MILITIA. SOME PRESENCE OF SERVED IN THE CITY. ALSO OBSERVED TO BE MANNING SOME ROAD BLOCKS IN RGF HELD AREAS.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE HO. NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. FC'S STAFF BRIEF WAS CONDUCTED AT 0700 HRS. A CONVOY DEPARTED THE HO AT 0700 HRS FOR KABALE (UGANDA) TO CART THE MISSION RESUPPLIES OF FUEL AND RATIONS

AND WFP HUMANITARIAN RELIEF ITEMS WHICH HAD BEEN AIRLIFTED TO ENTEBBE AIRPORT. OWING TO SOME ADMINISTRATIVE BOTTLENECKS THE CONVOY COULD NOT RETURN TODAY AS ORIGINALLY PLANNED. DFC IS NOW IN KAMPALA AND WILL RETURN WITH THE CONVOY TOMORROW. FC VISITED THE SOUTHERN PART OF THE COUNTRY UNDER MPF CONTROL. HE ALSO VISITED THE RPF REPAIRED BRIDGE ON RIVER AKANYARU BETWEEN GIHINGA AND SHINGA.

- B. UNONUE ADR IS GENERALLY CALM. ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. THE DUTCH DELEGATION LEFT FOR KAMPALA THIS MORNING AFTER A TWO DAY VISIT, 54 VEHICLES CROSSED FROM UGANDA TO RWANDA CARRYING 350 PASSENGERS OUT OF WHICH 225 WERE REFUGEES. FROM RWANDA INTO UGANDA, 52 VEHICLES CROSSED WITH 136 PASSENGERS. APPROXIMATELY 1,500 RWANDESE CROSSED AT CYANIKA TO WORK AND MARKETING IN UCANDA IN THE MORNING, AND RETURNED IN THE AFTERNOON. 1 X HELICOPTER IS OPERATIONAL. 10 X DIFFERENT NGOS CROSSED THE BORDER AT KATUNA WITH VARIOUS RELIEF ITEMS DURING THE PERIOD.
- C. <u>BYUBAT</u>. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE WAS ALSO GIVEN TO DISPLACED PERSONS LOCATED AT THE KIA AND THE STADIUM. ESCORTS WERE PROVIDED FOR OTHER DUTIES DURING THE PERIOD.
- D. TUN PL CONTINUED TO PROVIDE SECURITY TO DISPLACED PERSONS AT MERIDIEN HOTEL, KING FAISAL HOSPITAL AND HOTEL MILLES COLLINS. ALSO PROVIDE APC ESCORTS FOR OTHER DUTIES DURING THE PERIOD.
- E. MILOB THE NEW KIGALI SECTOR HO IS NOW OPERATIONAL. PROVIDED ESCORTS AND CITY PATROL TEAMS FOR HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. TEAMS WERE ALSO PROVIDED FOR LIAISON DUTIES BETWEEN THE FORCE AND THE WARRING FACTIONS.
- 5. UNCIVEOL. 15 ARE STILL STATIONED AT NAIROBI.
- 6. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. PROPOSALS WERE FORWARDED TO THE RGF ON THE RESUMPTION OF THE TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS OPERATIONS. A PATROL DESPATCHED TO STE FAMILLE AND STE ANDRE ORPHANAGES WERE DENIED ACCESS BY THE HGY. THE ICRC REPORTED THAT THE DISPLACED PERSONS CAMP AT KAMONY! ON THE KIGALI GITARAMA ROAD HAS BETWEEN 70,000 AND 120,000 DISPLACED PERSONS AND HAD NO SUPPLIES FOR THE PAST 15 DAYS DUE TO INSECURITY. PLANS ARE AFOOT TO CREATE A UN DISPLACED PERSONS CAMP. SOME 63 PERSONS AND 9 CATHOLIC BROTHERS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN MASSACRED IN NYAMIRAMBO LAST NIGHT. THE MATTER WAS REPORTED TO THE PREFECT OF KIGALI WIO HAS PROMISED TO INVESTIGATE. THE HA TEAM AND PSF MET WITH THE PREFECT OF KIGALI TO DISCUSS THE MOVEMENT OF ORPHANS.
