SITEED COVERING PERIOD 110600 JUN TO 111800B JUN 94.

NITH REDUCED HOSTILITIES BETWEEN THE TWO PACTIONS. HARASSING EXCHANGES OF MORTAR AND SMALL ARMS FIRE HOWEVER CONTINUED BETWEEN THE RGF AND RPF FROM THEIR RESPECTIVE POSITIONS IN KIGALI. THERE WERE NO MAJOR CHANGES IN THE DISPOSITIONS OF THE TWO WARRING FACTIONS IN THE SOUTH AND NORTH OF THE COUNTRY. THERE WERE ALSO NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN THE BATTLE SCENARIO. THE INFLUX OF DISPLACED PERSONS TO THE SOUTH STILL CONTINUES. GENDARMERIE AND MILITIA CONTINUE TO MAN ROAD BLOCKS IN RGF CONTROLLED AREAS. MR FLETCHER OF MAC LEFT TODAY FOR KABALE TO ATTEND A MEETING WITE THE HUMANITARIAN AGENCIES AND OTHER NGOS. HE WILL PASS THE NIGHT IN KABALE. THE ICRC CONVOY WHICH COULD NOT CROSS THE BORDER YESTERDAY ARRIVED IN KIGALI TODAY AT 1700 HRS. THE CONVOY CONSISTED OF 3 VEHICLES WITH HUMANITARIAN SUPPLIES. THE FIFTH TRIPARTITE CRASE FIRE MEETING WAS HELD AT FORCE HQ UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF THE DFC. THE MEETING ENDED WITH SIGNIFICANT PROGRESS. THE NEXT MEETING WILL BE HELD ON 13 JUNE 94.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES NOTHING TO REPORT.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. RPI RPF CONTINUED TO HARASS THE RGF POCKETS LEFT IN THE CITY WITH SPORADIC MORTAR AND SMALL ARMS FIRE. ALSO POUNDED MOUNT KIGALI AND GENDARMERIE CAMP AT KACHIRU WITH ARTY/MORTAR PIRE. THEY CONTINUE TO PUT PRESSURE ON RGF POSITIONS ON ALL FRONTS. NO MAJOR CHANGES OBSERVED IN THEIR DISPOSITIONS IN KIGALI. AN ATTEMPTED TO INFLITRATION THROUGH RGF LINES INTO RUHENCERI WAS NOT SUCCESSFUL.
- B: BGY. THE RGF WAS SUCCESSFUL IN STOPPING RPF INFILTRATION INTO RUHENGERI. CONTINUED TO FIGHT BACK FROM THEIR FOSITIONS IN NYAMIRANEO, KYCHIKIRU AND KIMIHURURA IN KIGALI. ALSO RETALIATED TO RPF FIRE FROM THE POSITIONS HELD BY THEM. CONSOLIDATING THEIR POSITIONS IN GITARAMA AND RUHENGERI. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN THEIR DISPOSITIONS IN THE CITY. ALSO REPORTED TO HAVE RECEIVED A LARGE QUANTITY OF SMALL ARMS AMMUNITION AND STILL FACING A SHORTAGE OF HEAVY WEAPONS AMMUNITION. THOUSANDS OF YOUNG MEN ARE REPORTED TO BE RECEIVING TRAINING IN RUSHASHI NORTH OF KIGALI.
- C. <u>HILITIA.</u> CONTINUE TO MAN SOME CHECK POINTS IN RGF CONTROLLED ARBAS IN THE CITY. SOME OF THEIR EXECUTIVES WERE SEEN IN THE CITY TODAY.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE HO. NORMAL ROUTINE WORKS WERE CONDUCTED. STAFF BRIEFING WAS CONDUCTED BY THE DFC AT 0700 HRS. DFC CHAIRED

THE FIFTH ROUND OF THE CHASE FIRE TALKS BETWEEN THE RGF AND RPF HELD AT FORCE HQ. THE MEETING ENDED WITH ABOUT HALF OF THE CHASE FIRE DOCUMENT BEING DISCUSSED. THE NEXT MEETING IS SCHEDULED FOR ON 13 JUNE 94.

- B. DNONDE. AREA OF OPERATION IS CALM. ROUTINE PATROL WERE CARRIED OUT IN AGR. THREE HELICOPTERS ARE PRESENTLY OPERATIONAL.
- C. BYUEAT. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROVIDED PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PROPLE AT KIA AND AMAHORO STADIUM. PROVIDED ESCORTS RGF DELEGATION TO THE CEASE FIRE CONFERENCE. A 4 YR OLD CHILD DIED AT THE KIA DISPLACED PERSONS CAMP. HE HAS SINCE BEEN BURIED.
- D. TUN PLATOCH (+). AREA OF OPERATION WAS RELATIVELY CALM. PROVIDED SECURITY AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PERSONS AT MILLE COLLINS HOTEL, MERIDIEN HOTEL AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. ALSO CARRIED OUT ESCORT DUTIES WITH APCS.
- E. MILOS: MILOS TEAMS WERE EMPLOYED FOR THE FOL DUTIES DURING: THE PERIOD:
 - (1) MONITORING ACTIVITIES AROUND DISPLACED PERSONS CAMPS AT ST MICHAEL AND RED CROSS.
 - (2) TWO TEAMS WENT TO KAGITUMBA TO ESCORT RED CROSS VEHICLES AND UNAMIR PERSONNEL ARRIVING THROUGH ENTERES FROM NAIROBI TO KIGALI.
 - (3) TWO TRAMS ESCORTED OFFICIALS OF PSF FOR WATER DUTIES FOR DISPLACED PERSONS.
 - (4) ONE TRAM ESCORTED HAT OFFICIAL TO KABALE FOR A CONFERENCE.
 - (5) ONE TRAM ESCORTED OFFICIALS OF THE WFP FROM KIA TO KING FAISAL HOSPITAL FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF RELIEF ITEMS.
 - (6) FOUR X UNMO TEAMS WERE EMPLOYED AS PART OF THE SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE CEASE FIRE MEETING HELD TODAY.
 - (7) RPF SECTOR MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN THEIR SECTOR.
- 5. INCLUPOL. 15 ARE STILL IN NAIROBI.
- 6. MUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES REPORTS FROM THE PRIESTS FROM ST ANDRE, WHO WERE INJURED DURING THE MASSACRE INCIDENT STATE THAT 18 PERSONS WERE KILLED IN THE CHURCH WHILE 180 WERE TAKEN AWAY TO AN UNKNOWN DESTINATION BY THE MILITIAMEN WHO CAME TO THE CHURCH. UNICEF STARTED A VACCINATION PROGRAM WITH MEASLES AND ANTI-TETANUS VACCINATIONS. 260 WOMEN AND CHILDREN AT KIA REFUGEE CAMP RECEIVED VACCINATIONS. UNICEF ISSUED ONE BASIC MEDICAL KIT TO THE GHANBATT MEDICAL SECTION FOR THE TREATMENT OF REFUGEES AT KIA CAMP. 20 CARTONS OF BISCUITS, 20 JERRY CANS OF WATER, 10 BOXES OF BP5 BISCUITS AND 10 BOXES OF MILK WERE DELIVERED TO ST-PAUL. WFP DELIVERED 492 BOXES OF BISCUITS TO KING FAISAL

HOSPITAL AND 228 BOXES TO KIA CAMP, AHT/HAC WENT TO KABALE TODAY FOR A MEETING WITH THE OTHER MGO REPRESENTATIVES TO PLAN A RECCE TO AREAS WITHIN THE RPF TERRITORY. ICRC TREATED 9 PATIENTS IN THEIR HOSPITAL, IN CYANGUGU PREFECTURE THE ICRC TRANSFERRED 2158 DISPLACED PERSONS FROM: CYANGUGU STADIUM TO NYARUSHASHI. THEY ALSO DELIVERED 500 POTS, 500 PLASTIC SHEETS, 200 LITERS OF OIL, 800 KGs OF BEANS AND 1500 KGs OF CORN TO THE NYARUSHASHI CAMP. IN NIBIRIZI HOSPITAL ICRC CARRIED OUT POST OPERATIVE CARE TO 70 PATIENTS. IN NYANZA HOSPITAL 240 IN PATIENTS, 41 BLIND ORPHANS, 66 ORPHANS AND 84 LOCAL STAPPS ARE AT RISK DUE TO THE UNHYGIENIC SITUATION IN THE CAMP. THERE IS NO NATER AVAILABLE IN THE AREA. 80000 DISPLACED PERSONS ARE LOCATED IN RUHANGO AREA WITHOUT ANY SUPPLIES. AN ICRC CONVOY ARRIVED TODAY AT 1730 HRS FROM UGANDA WITH STAPF FOR ICRC AND KING FAISAL HOSPITALS. ICRC DISTRIBUTED 36 TONS OF RICE, 36 TONS OF BEANS, 1.3 TONS OF SALT AND 5 TONS OF OIL TO 9000 DISPLACED PERSONS IN RUTARE. THE ICRC HAS COMPLETED THE PAPER WORK FOR THE FIRST AIRLIFT OF 50 TONS OF CARGO INTO GOMA (ZAIRE) BEGINNING NEXT WEEK.
