STYREP COVERING PERIOD 240600B JUNE TO 241800B JUNE 94.

- 1. GEN SITUATION. THE GENERAL SITUATION REMAINED TENSE AND FLUID THROUGHOUT THE DAY. RPF CONTINUED TO SQUEEZE THE RGF POCKETS OF RESISTANCE LEFT IN THE CITY ARTY/MORTAR AND HMG FIRE. THE FIRE FIGHT, WHICH STARTED IN THE HORNING AND CONTINUED TILL EARLY AFTERNOON WAS IN AND AROUND VILLAGE URUGHIRO, HYAMIRAHBO, KIMIHURURA AND THE CITY CENTER. ONE HORTAR SHELL LANDED AT RED CROSS HOSPITAL COMPOUND KILLING FIVE AND HOUNDING SEVERAL OTHERS. TWO PEOPLE WERE REPORTED SHOT DEAD WHEN THEY WENT TO FETCH WATER. SEVERAL OTHERS WERE WOUNDED. DEMONSTRATIONS BY DISPLACED PERSONS IN RPF HELD AREAS WERE REPORTED EARLY THIS HORNING IN KABUGA—KIGALI AGAINST THE FRENCH INITIATIVE. EXCHANGES OF PIRE CONTINUED IN AND BUTARE. NO CHANGES IN THE BATTLE SITUATION HAS BEEN REPORTED FROM THE MORTH. A CONVOY OF APCS AND FUEL ARRIVED KIGALI FROM UGANDA. DFC VISITED AMAHORO STADIUM, KIA AND HERIDIEN HOTEL. TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PEOPLE DID HOT TAKE PLACE TODAY DUE TO HEAVY FIGHTING IN THE CITY CENTER.
- POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE LEADER OF THE RPP UNAMIR CEASE PIRE NEGOTIATING THAM HELD A PRESS CONFERENCE TODAY AT WHICH HE SAID THAT THE RPF WELCOMES THE CONTINUED STAY IN RWANDA BUT WOULD LIKE TO SEE A RAPID BUILD UP OF THE FORCE SO THAT THE FRENCH CAN LEAVE RHANDA EARLY. THIS NARKS A SOFTENING IN THE TONE OF THE RPF ON THEIR EARLIER STANCE ON THE PRENCH INITIATIVE.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. BPF. RPF CONTINUED TO PRESSURIZE RGF POSITIONS IN VILLAGE URUGWIRO, KIMIHURURA AND THE CITY CENTER. DEMONSTRATIONS BY RPF SYMPATHIZER WERE REPORTED IN KABUGA. THEY DISPLAYED PLACARDS WITH: MESSAGES AND SLOGANS AGAINST THE FRENCH INTERVENTION.
- B. RGP. RGF CONTINUED TO FIGHT BACK FROM THEIR POSITIONS WITH ARTY/MORTAR, HGM AND SAG FIRE. GENDARMES CONTINUED TO MAN ROAD BLOCKS IN RGF HELD AREAS. NO CHANGES HAVE BEEN REPORTED IN THE SITUATION AND DISPOSITIONS IN THE HORTH. RELATIONS BETWEEN THE RGF AND UNAMIR COMMAND SEEM TO BE ON THE DOWNWARD TREND.
- C. HILITIA. MILITIA ACTIVITIES CONTINUE TO BE ON THE INCREASE. CONTINUED TO HAN ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN RGF AREAS. THERE HAS NOT BEEN ANY MARKED CHANGE IN THEIR HOSTILE BEHAVIOR.

4. ONN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. PORCE HO. NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. A STAFF BRIEF WAS CONDUCTED BY FC AT 0700 HRS. HE DISCUSSED THE CURRENT SECURITY SITUATION AND

THE PROBABLE IMPACT OF THE ARRIVAL OF THE FRENCH ON UNAMIR OPERATIONS. DPC PAID A WORKING VISIT TO KIA, AMAHORO AND HOTEL MERIDIEN TO FAMILIARIZE HIMSELF WITH THE PROBLEMS IN THESE AREAS AND TO INTERACT WITH THE TROOPS. A MEDALS PARADE REMEARSAL WAS HELD IN THE AFTERNOOM.

- B. UMONUR AREA OF OPERATIONS REMAINED CAIM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS. BORDER CROSSING: 36 VEHS CROSSED INTO RHANDA FROM UGANDA WITH 376 PASSENGERS, 273 WERE REFUGEES. 37 VEHS CROSSED INTO UGANDA FROM RWANDA WITH 166 PASSENGERS, 21 WERE REFUGEES. 20 VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN AID AGENCIES CROSSED INTO RWANDA WITH VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN RELIEF ITEMS FOR DISTRIBUTION IN RPF CONTROLLED AREAS.
- C. GEANRATT. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, ANAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE: HQ. PROTECTION: AND HUMANITARIAM ASSISTANCE WAS ALSO GIVEN: TO DISPLACED PERSONS LOCATED AT THE KIA AND THE STADIUM. OWN: MEDICAL STAFF PROVIDED MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TO 9 DISPLACED PERSONS.
- D. THE PL CONTINUED TO BE PROVIDE SECURITY AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL AND HOTEL HERIDIEN. OBSERVED SHELLING AND FIRING AT KINIHURURA CAMP, CITY CENTER AND CAMP KIGALI. PROVIDED PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ABBISTANCE TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL AND HOTEL MERIDIEN.
- E. MILOB. DUTIES PERFORMED TODAY ARE AS FOLLOWS:
 - (1) MILOB TEAMS ESCORTED OFFICIALS OF PSF AND MSF TO REFUGEES CAMPS IN KIGALI DURING THE PERIOD.
 - (2) 5 HILOB TEAMS ESCORTED PAX AND UNAMIR LOG CONVOY FROM KAGITUHBA TO KIGALI.
- 5. UNCIVEOL. CONTINUED TO BE EXPLOYED WITH MILOBS.
- 6. HUMANITAPIAN ACTIVITIES. THE PLANNED HOVEMENT OF DISPLACED PERSONS FROM: THE AIRPORT TO KING FAISAL HOSPITAL WAS NOT CONDUCTED DUE TO THE INTENSE FIGHTING AROUND THE MERIDIEN ROUND ABOUT. UNICEF PREPARED BOXES OF MEDICAL SUPPLIES FOR USE BY ICRC HOSPITAL AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. UNICEF CARRIED OUT VACCINATION CAMPAIGN AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. 96 PERSONS WERE VACCINATED, BRINGING THE TOTAL NUMBER OF PERSONS VACCINATED SO FAR TO 2,669. ICRC DELIVERED IN HUSHA AN UNKNOWN QUANTITY OF FOOD. THE SAME CONVOY WILL PROCEED TOMORROW TO DELIVER HEDICAL SUPPLIES AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. A MEETING WAS HELD AT UNAMIR HQ BETWEEN RPF HUMANITARIAN REPRESENTATIVES, THE ICRC AND UNAMIR HAC TO DISCUSS THE PROCEDURES THAT WILL BE FOLLOWED FOR DELIVERIES OF FOOD OR MEDICAL SUPPLIES IN RFF CONTROLLED AREAS. THE ICRC HOSPITAL WAS HIT TODAY BY INDIRECT FIRE. THE SHELL WHICH LANDED ON THE INTENSIVE CARE UNIT RESULTED IN THE DEATH OF 5 PATIENTS AND INJURIES TO MANY MORE THAT WERE ALREADY HOUNDED.
