- QUITE IN COMPARISON TO THE PERIOD WAS OBSERVED TO BE RELATIVELY QUITE IN COMPARISON TO THE PREVIOUS NIGHT. HOWEVER, INTERMITTENT SHELLING AND SAS FIRE CONTINUED IN THE WESTERN AND SOUTH WESTERN PARTS OF THE KIGALI CITY. THE MAIN AREAS OF FIGHTING WERE AROUND KACHIYRU, KIMIHURURA, GIKONDO, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTRE. MILITIA AND INTERHAMME ACTIVITIES CONTINUE TO BE ON THE INCREASE. THERE IS NO CHANGE IN THE SITUATION IN THE NORTH AND IN THE SOUTH THE RPF IS NOW EASING THE RESTRICTIONS IT HAD EARLIER ON IMPOSED ON UNAMIR. THE TRANSFER OF ORPHANE AND WOUNDED PERSONS FROM ST MITCHEL TO KING FAISAL HOSPITAL MAY BE CARRIED OUT TODAY IF THE GENERAL SECURITY SITUATION PERMITS. THREE NEW APCS, TYPE M-113 ARRIVED FROM ENTESSEE TO KIGALI LAST NIGHT. TWO MILOS TEAMS HECORTED UNAMIR PERSONNEL AND OTHER ROAD CONVOYS PROCEEDING TO NAIROBI/UGANDA. THE DFC IS SCHEDULED TO MEET COS RGF TODAY.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE RPP POLITICAL LEADERSHIP HAS STRESSED THE NEED FOR THE FAST BUILD UP OF THE FORCE IN ORDER TO PREVENT THE FRENCH STAYING LONGER THAN PLANNED. THE INTERIM GOVT HAS EXPRESSED ITS SATISFACTION AT THE DEPLOYMENT OF THE FRENCH SO FAR.

3. PACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. RPF. RPF CONTINUED THEIR PRESSURE ON RGF POSITIONS IN KIMIHURURA, GIKONDO AND NYAMIRAMBO WITH ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SAME FIRE OVER NIGHT AND THIS MORNING. SEEM TO HAVE GAINED SOME MORE GROUND IN THE CITY AFTER THE EXCHANGES OF THE LAST FEW DAYS. NO CHANGES IN THEIR DISPOSITION IN THE MORTH AND IN THE SOUTH.
- B: RGF: CONTINUE TO ADOPT A DEFENSIVE POSTURE WITHIN KIMIHURURA, GIKONDO AND OTHER PARTS OF THE CITY. THERE IS NO CHANGE IN THEIR DISPOSITIONS IN THE NORTH AND IN THE SOUTH: THEIR MORALE IS STILL HIGH.
- C. MILITIA. CONTINUE TO CONTROL AND MAN ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN RGF HELD ARBAS WHERE THEY CONTINUE TO BE A THREAT TO THE CIVILIAN POPULATION.
