## SITERP COVERING PERIOD 030600B JULY TO 031800B JULY 94.

- GET SITUATION. THE DAY WAS COMPARATIVELY QUIET. HOWEVER THE HOSTILITY BETWEEN THE TWO FACTIONS CONTINUED WITH LESS INTENSITY. RPF CONTINUED TO PUT PRESEURE ON RGF POSITIONS IN KYCHIRU CAMP, KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO AND CITY CENTER. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES in the deployment of eoth warring parties in kigali. Militia and INTERHAMME ACTIVITIES CONTINUES IN RGP CONTROL AREAS, THERE ARE NO CHANGES IN THE SITUATION IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH OF THE COUNTRY. THE FRENCH COALITION PORCES CONTINUED HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES WITHIN THEIR DEMARCATED OPERATION LINE IN WEST OF THE COUNTRY. ONE UNDO TEAM WAS TASKED TO GO TO THE RGF HQ ON LIAISON duties. On the way to the city center the unmo vehicle was fired NEAR THE SOPECYA GAS STATION ON THE BOULEVARD DE L'OUA AT 1130 HRS. MAJOR S ANTONOV, UNID 708 OF RUSSIA SUSTAINED BULLET INJURIES. HE WAS EVACUATED TO KING FAISAL HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT. THE OFFICER IS PRESENTLY OUT OF DANGER. DFC HAD A DETAIL DISCUSSION WITH RPF SENIOR OFFICERS ON UNAMIR'S FUTURE REQUIREMENT OF ACCOMMODATION. RPF ACCEPTED MOST OF THE PROPOSALE. A HIGH LEVEL HUMANITARIAN DELEGATION LED BY ME GLYNNE EVANS, HEAD OF UN DEPT AT UK FOREIGN AND COMMONWEALTH OFFICE ARRIVED KIGALI THIS AFTERNOON. THE TEAM WAS BRIEFED IN THE UNAMIR FORCE HO BY FC, CHIEF OF OPERATIONS AND HAC. THE FIRST RECREATIONAL TRIP TO NAIROBI HAS STARTED TODAY BY SENDING THO OFFICERS AND 30 SOLDIERS FOR A PHRIOD OF ONE WEEK.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. RWANDESE PARLIAMENT WILL TAKE AN CATH IN GISENYI TOMORROW. ALL THE PARTIES WILL REPRESENT IN THE HOUSE OF COMMONS EXCEPT RPF. PRESIDENT OF RWANDA STATED THAT IT IS NOW THE TIME TO FILL UP THE CONSTITUTIONAL GAPS. THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION ON BEHALF OF THE RWANDESE GOVERNMENT HAD DENIED THE ARRIVAL OF THE UN HUMAN RIGHT COMMISSION REPORTER IN THE COUNTRY. HE ALSO SAID THAT THE REPORTER DID NOT RECEIVE VISA FROM ANY RWANDESE EMBASSY SO HE CANNOT BE ACCEPTED BY ANY RWANDESE OFFICIALS.

## 3. PACTICHAL ACTIVITIES.

A. BPE. RPF CONTINUED THEIR PRESSURE ON RGF FOCKETS OF RESISTANCE IN KYCHIRU, GIKONDO, NYANIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTER WITH ARTY/MORTARS, HMG AND SAS FIRE. RPF LAUNCHED A MAJOR OFFENSIVE ON RGF FOSITIONS IN CAMP KYCHIRU HARLY THIS MORNING BUT NO SIGNIFICANT SUCCESS COULD BE ACHIEVED. HOWEVER THEY INFLICTED CAUSALITIES ON RGF SIDES. RFF KEPT ON POUNDING ON RGF POSITIONS IN MONT KIGALI AND KYCHIRU GENDARMERIE CAMP THROUGH OUT THE DAY. NO MAJOR CHANGES IN DISPOSITIONS HAVE BEEN REPORTED. THE MORALE OF THE RPF TROOPS APPEARS TO BE IMPROVING AND NOW THEY ARE MORE OPTIMISTIC AND PROUD OF THEIR VICTORIES. HOWEVER THEY ARE RUNNING SHORTAGE OF FOOD SUPPLIES. MSF BELGIUM REPORTS IN A PRESS RELEASE THAT RPF HAVE ORDERED 50,000 TO 100,000 PERSONS TO MOVE OUT FROM NYANZA AND GO TO RELIMA. THEY HAVE ALSO ORDERED TO MOVE OUT 1500 PATIENTS FROM THE LOCAL

HOSPITAL. THE CASES OF DEHYDRATION AND DYSENTERIES HAVE BEEN NOTICED AND THE MSF BELGIUM ARE NOT CAPABLE TO MEET THE SITUATION DUE TO LACK OF MEDICAL SUPPLIES.

B. EGE. RGF SEEMS TO BE TIRED AND FRUSTRATED DUB TO LACK OF FOOD, CLOTHING, BEBR AND OTHER WAR SUPPLIES. RGF HAVE UNDERSTOOD BY NOW THAT PRENCH TROOPS ARE NOT COMING TO KIGALI TO RESCUE THEM. RGF CONTINUED TO FIGHT BACK FROM THEIR POSITIONS WITH LESS HOPE OF VICTORY. RGF SUSTAINED A LOT OF CASUALTIES IN THE BATTLE OF CAMP KACYIRU BARLY THIS MORNING. NO CHANGE IN THE DISPOSITIONS IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH.

C. MILITIA. MILITIA AND INTERHAMME ARE STILL ACTIVE THOUGH THEY LACK FOOD AND OTHER SUPPLIES. CONTINUED TO CONTROL ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN RGF AREAS.

## 4. OHN HILITARY ACTIVITIES.

- A. FORCE HO. NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. PREPARATIONS FOR THE EXPANDED UNAMIR FORCE CONTINUED. A HIGH LEVEL HUMANITARIAN DELEGATION LED BY MS GLYNNE EVANS, HEAD OF UN DEPT AT UK FOREIGN AND COMMONWRALTH OFFICE HAVE ARRIVED KIGALI THIS AFTERNOON ON A TWO DAY VISIT TO GET, FIRST HAND IMPRESSION ON THE SITUATION IN RWANDA. THE FIRST BATCH OF 30 TROOPS AND TWO OFFICERS FOR RECREATIONAL TRIP TO NAIROBI HAS STARTED TODAY.
- B. UNDMUE. AREA OF OFERATIONS REMAINED CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE FATROLS. ACMO VISITED ENTEBEE ON 02 JULY. MR TEDLA TESHOME, RESIDENT REPRESENTATIVE OF UNDF PAID A VISIT TO UNOMUR HQ TODAY. CONTINUED TO COORDINATE MOVEMENT OF PERSONNEL FROM KIGALI TO ENTEBBE. BORDER CROSSING: 20 VEHE CROSSED INTO UGANDA FROM RWANDA WITH 81 PASSENGERS. 26 VEHE CROSSED INTO RWANDA FROM UGANDA WITH 528 PASSENGERS OUT OF WHICH 455 WERE REFUGERS. 18 VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN AGENCIES ENTERED RWANDA FROM UGANDA WITH VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN RELIEFITEMS FOR DISTRIBUTION IN RFF CONTROLLED AREAS. THREE HELICOPTERS ARE PRESENTLY OPERATIONAL.
- C. GHANGATT, PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE WAS ALSO GIVEN TO DISPLACED PERSONS LOCATED AT THE KIA AND THE STADIUM. THE BATTALION MEDICAL OFFICER TREATED 12 DISPLACED PERSONS.
- D. TUN PL. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL AND HOTEL MERIDIEN. ALSO PROVIDED HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT HOTEL MERIDIEN AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL.
- E. MILOR. PLANNING, COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOB ACTIVITIES WAS CARRIED OUT. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE ESCORT AND MONITORING TEAMS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) MILOBS ESCORTED MSF PERSONNEL TO REFUGEE CAMPS AT KING PAISAL HOSPITAL, KIA AND AMAHORO STADIUM.
- (2) CARRIED OUT ESCORT DUTIES FROM KIGALI TO KAGITUMBA AND BACK. ALSO ESCORTED PERSONNEL, AND LOGISTICS CONVOY FROM KIGALI TO KAYONZA.
- PRENCH COALITION FORCES ACTIVITIES, FRENCH TROOPS CARRIED OUT THEIR HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. 600 ORPHANS WERE EVACUATED BY FRENCH TROOPS FROM NORTH OF BUTARE. THEY WERE UPON PROM RPF LOCATION AND PRENCH TROOPS RETURNED THE FIRE, NO CASUALTIES. THE FRENCH TROOPS ARE AWAITING A REACTION TO THEIR YESTERDAY'S PROPOSAL TO SET UP A HUMANITARIAN NEUTRAL ZONE.

  - A. HAC. MSF AND ICRC REPRESENTATIVE HELD A MEETING WITH THE COMMITTEE OF KING PAISAL HOSPITAL TO DISCUSS THE POLLOWING:
    - (1) MOVEMENT OF DISPLACED PERSONS TO ACCOMMODATE NOUNDED PERSONS FROM ICRC.
      - CONTROL OF THE DISTRIBUTION OF FOOD. (2)
      - CONTROL OF MEDICAL WASTE. (3)
  - FOLLOWING Decisions WERE TAKEN IN THE MEETING: В.
    - THE COMMITTEE WILL VACATE SOME DISPLACED PERSONS TO FACILITATE MEF ACTIVITIES IN THE HOSPITAL. HAC WILL OBTAINS A WRITTEN AGREEMENT FROM ROF IN THIS REGARDS.
    - THE COMMITTER WILL CONTROL FOOD DISTRIBUTION BASED ON ADVICE GIVEN BY THE AID AGENCIES.
    - ICRC WILL ENSURE ALL MEDICAL WASTE ARE BURNED. (3)
  - ADRA REPORTED ABOUT A LARGE NUMBER OF DISPLACED HUTUS MOVING BACK TO KIGALI FROM THE DIRECTION OF MONT KIGALI. IT ALSO REPORTED THAT RDF ARE FORCING A LARGE NO OF DISPLACED PERSONS FROM NYANZA TO RILIMA.
  - D. HFP HAS CONTACTED THEIR HQ TO DETERMINE THE NEXT ARRIVAL OF FOOD FOR KIGALI. ICRC DELIVERED 83 TONS OF FOOD TO 10,000 DISPLACED PERSONS IN RELIMA AND 79 TONE OF FOOD IN RUBHSKI FOR 7468 PERSONS. ICRC AIR LIFTED 70 TONE OF FOOD FROM NAIROBI TO GOMA. ICRC TREATED 49 PATIENTS.
