- 1. GET SITUATION. THE GENERAL SITUATION REMAINED CALM THROUGHOUT THE NIGHT. MANY REPUGEES AND DISPLACED PEOPLE CONTINUED TO RETURN TO THEIR HOMES IN KIGALI CITY. THE SITUATION IN THE SOUTH OF THE COUNTRY ALSO REMAINED CALM. THE RPF CONTINUED TO REINFORCE THEIR UNITS IN THE NORTH WEST OF THE COUNTRY WHILE THE RGF CONTINUED TO CONSOLIDATE THEIR POSITIONS IN AND AROUND RUHENGERI AND GISENYI WHERE FIGHTING IS STILL GOING ON. RPF TROOPS WERE SPOTTED ON THE NKOTO HILLS WHICH IS 1 KM INSIDE HUMANITARIAN PROTECTED ZONE, THE RPF IS ALSO MAKING FRANTIC EFFORTS TO PUT A GOVT IN PLACE SCONEST.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES, THE RPF IS CALLING ON THE PRESIDENTS OF ALL THE MODERATE POLITICAL PARTIES TO COME DOWN TO KIGALI FOR A MESTING. THE MESTING IS SCHEDULED FOR 1500 HRS TODAY, THE RPF IS CLAIMING THE PRESIDENCY FOLLOWING THEIR MILITARY VICTORY,

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. BPF. RPF CONTINUED TO ASSIST AND SUPERVISE THE RETURN OF DISPLACED PROPLE BACK INTO KIGALI. THEIR ADVANCE TOWARDS RUHENGERI AND GISENYI CONTINUES. AT ABOUT 2200 HRS 25 TRUCKS LOADED WITH RPF TROOPS WERE OBSERVED MOVING FROM GENERAL AREA OF RWAMAGANA THROUGH KIGALI TOWARDS THE NORTH WEST OF THE COUNTRY. IT IS BELIEVED THAT THESE ARE TROOPS BEING SENT AS REINFORCEMENT. RPF IS REPORTEDLY ENTERED IN HUMANITARIAN PROTECTED ZONE IN GENERAL AREA NKOTO WHICH IS LOCATED SOUTH OF BIRAMBO. THEY CONTINUE TO CONSOLIDATE THEIR POSITIONS IN THE CITY.
- B. RGY. RGF CONTINUED TO CONSOLIDATE THEIR POSITIONS IN AREAS UNDER THEIR CONTROL. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES HAVE BEEN REPORTED. THEY MAY WITHDRAW FROM RUHENGERI IF RPF PUTS PRESSURE.
- C. MILITIA. THEIR ACTIVITIES CONTINUE IN THE RGP CONTROLLED AREAS.

4. ONN HILITARY ACTIVITIES

- A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. PREPARATIONS FOR THE EXPANDED UNAMIR FORCE CONTINUED. GHANBATT TROOPS CONTINUE TO ARRIVE FROM ENTEBBE. TRAINING ON THE APCS HAS STARTED WITH GHANBATT TROOPS. FOR RETURNS TODAY FROM UGANDA. A RECCE TRAM LEAVES THIS LOCATION FOR BUXAVU TODAY TO ESTABLISH LIAISON WITH THE FRENCH IN THE HPZ. THE FRENCH LIAISON TEAM IS EXPECTED IN TODAY.
- B. UNCMUR. AREA OF OPERATION WAS CALM, ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED. NOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO REPORT.
- C. GHANDATT, PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM,

THE MERIDIEN HOTEL, KING PAISAL HOSPITAL AND FORCE HQ. PROTECTED DISPLACED PERSONS IN THESE SAME LOCATIONS. CONDUCTED PATROLS WITHIN KIA GENERAL AREA AND ALONG THE RUNNAY FROM 2230 HRS TO 2330 HRS AND FROM 0400 HRS TO 0500 HRS.

- D. MILON. CONTINUED TO PLAN AND PREPARE FOR DEPLOYMENT AS PER NEW MANDATE. MILOB TEAM IN GOMA CONTINUED TO LINISE WITH THE PRENCH COALITION FORCES.
- 5. UNCIVPOL. ALL ARE IN NAIROBI.
- 6. PREMER COALITION MILITARY ACTIVITIE. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PEOPLE WITHIN THE HUMANITARIAN PROTECTED ZONE AND TO ALSO DISARM MILITIA WITHIN THEIR CONTROLLED AREAS.
- 7. EURANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. NO CHANGE FROM PREVIOUS SITREP.
- 8. CIVIL AFFAIRS, NTR.
- 9. LOGISTICS. NO CHANGE FROM PREVIOUS SITREP.
