# SITTER COVERING PERIOD 151801H JULY TO 161800H JULY 94.

- THE SITUATION DURING THE DAY REMAINED CALM GET SITUATION. THROUGHOUT. REP CONTINUED TO CONTROL KIGALI AND ASSISTING PEOPLE TO RETURN TO RIGALI. THE RPF ARE REPORTED TO HAVE PIRED AT A FRENCH JEEP LATER THIS AFTERNOON ON THE ROAD TO KIEUYE FROM GITARAHA. NO REPORTS OF ANY CASUALTIES HAVE DEEN REPORTED. RFF advance towards gisenyl is reported to have been slowed down. A PARATROOPS BY FROM THE ARMED PORCES OF ZAIRE IS REPORTED TO HAVE HOVED TO GONA TO ASSIST IN SECURITY OF THE AREA. HANY PEOPLE AND DCP SOLDIERS PLUS HILITIA AND INTERHANCE STILL CONTINUE TO CROSS into gona, Maire. 919 displaced people here transported to kigali FROM BYUNDA AND RUTARE. FC VIBITED COMA AND RETURNED THIS EVENING. BREG HELD A HEETING WITH HUMANITARIAN AID AGENCIES AND OTHER HOOS. HE BRIEFED THEN ON THE CURRENT HILITARY AND POLITICAL SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY. THE VARIOUS AID AGENCIES OUTLINED THEIR CURRENT STATE OF PREPARATION. SRSG ALSO HELD DISCUSSIONS WITH THE INTERIN PRIME MINISTER.
- POLLOWING HIS HEETING WITH GENERAL POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. TODAY YESTERDAY, HITH IR JUSTIN SRSG MET PAUL KAGANE THAGIRAHUNGU, PRIME HINISTER DESIGNATE. THEY EXCHANGED VIEWS ON THE NECESSITY FOR AN INDEDIATE CEASE PIRE AND THE EARLY FORMATION OF A BROAD BABED TRANSITIONAL GOVERNMENT WITHIN THE FRANK MORK OF THE ARUSHA PRACE AGRESHENT. THEY AGREED TO BE IN CONTINUOUS CONTACT HITH EACH OTHER AND TO WORK FOR A SPEEDY RESUMPTION OF THE PEACE PROCESS AND FOR NATIONAL RECONCILIATION. SRSG ALSO HET WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF UN AID AGENCIES AND NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS TO DETERMINE WAYS AND MEANS OF FACILITATING RELIEF OPERATIONS. THE ORGANIZATIONS COMPLAINED OF HAVING SUFFERED SEVERE LOSSES OF RELIEF SUPPLIES AND VEHICLES FROM LARGE SCALE LOOTING. THEY URGED UNANIR TO BRING THIS MATTER TO THE ATTENTION OF THE AUTHORITIES.

#### 3. VACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPP. RPF CONTINUED TO CONTROL RIGALI AND HUCH OF THE COUNTRY SIDE. THEY CONTINUED TO POSE SERIOUS THREAT TO CIVILIANS IN GISENYI NHO ARE CURRENTLY ON THE NOVE TO GONA, ZAIRE. THEY ARE REPORTED TO HAVE HALTED THEIR ADVANCE TOWARDS GISENYI AT KORA RG-3821. THEY HAVE FIRED AT A FRENCH JEEP ON THE ROAD TO RIBUYE FROM GITARAMA. CONTINUED TO COOPERATE WITH UMANIR IN HOVEMENT OF DISPLACED PEOPLE RETURNING TO RIGALI FROM THE NORTH. RPF TODAY COLLECTED HEAPONS WHICH WERE CONFISCATED FROM DISPLACED PERSONS AT KIA.

B. RGY. RGY ACTIVITIES ARE CONCENTRATED BEHIND THE FRENCH COALITION FORCE HUMANITARIAN PROTECTED ZONE. THEY ARE REPORTED ALSO REPORTED TO HAVE CROSSED INTO GOMA, ZAIRE WHERE THE ZAIRE TROOPS ARE REPORTED TO BE CONTINUING IN

DISARMING THEM. CONTACTS WITH RGF IS A BIG PROBLEM AS THEY ARE ALL ON THE MOVE TOGETHER WITH THE ENTIRE COMMAND ELEMENT.

C. MILITIA. MILITIA AND INTERNAMME CONTINUE TO MOVE ACROSS INTO GONA, ZAIRE.

### 4. OSB MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE HO. NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. FC'S. STAFF BRIEF WAS CONDUCTED AT 0800 HRS AND 1830 HRS. SREG HELD A HEETING WITH VARIOUS MGOS AND AID AGENCIES. HE OUTLINED ABOUT THE CURRENT POLITICAL AND HILITARY SITUATION AND EXPLAINED THEIR IMPORTANCE IN THE PRESENT SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY. FC VISITED GOMA TO ACCESS THE CURRENT SITUATION IN THE AREA. SREG HET WITH THE INTERIM PRIME: HIMISTER MR PAUSTIN THAGNIRAMUNGU LATER IN THE DAY AND DISCUSSED A WIDE RANGE OF POLITICAL ISSUES. ANOTHER MEETING HAS HELD AT FORCE HQ HITH RPF REGARDING VARIOUS INFRASTRUCTURE THAT UNAMIR PLANS TO USE IN KIGALI CITY.

B. UNCHUE. AREA OF OPERATIONS REMAINED CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN THE AREA. THREE HELICOPTERS REMAINED OPERATIONAL DURING THE PERIOD. DETAILS OF BORDER CROSSING BETWEEN UGANDA AND RNANDA WERE AS FOLLOWS:

- D. HILOR. THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES WERE UNDERTAKEN TODAY:
  - (1) EVACUATED A TOTAL OF 919 DISPLACED PERSONS FROM BYUHBA AND RUTARE TO KIGALI.
  - (2) ESCORTED COMES TECH TEAM TO INSPECT AND SERVICE THE COMES REPEATER AT HOURT JARL.
- E. FRENCH COALITION FORCES ACTIVITIES. THE FRENCH COALITION: FORCES CONTINUED TO PROVIDE HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE: TO THE HIGH: INFLUX OF REFUGEES IN COORDINATION WITH OTHER HUMANITARIAN: ACENCIES. IT WAS REPORTED THAT ONE OF THEIR JEEPS WAS FIRED UPON BY RPF 15 KMs FROM KIBUYE TOWARDS: GITARAMA. THEY: CONTINUED TO REMAIN VIGILANT AS RPP CONTINUED TO POSE SCHE THREAT IN GISENYI AREA.
- 6. UNCTYPOL. ALL ARE IN HAIROBI.
- 7. HUMANITARIAM ACTIVITIES. DURING THE PAST 24 HRS THE POLLOWING ACTIVITIES WERE UNDERTAKEN:

#### A. DISPLACED PEOPLE

- (1) UNAMIR ASSISTED IN THE TRANSPORTATION OF 449 DISPLACED PERSONS FROM A CAMP IN SYUMBA TO RIGALI AND 470 DISPLACED PERSONS FROM RUTARE TO KIGALI.
- (2) HSF HAS REPORTED THAT A FEW Refugees WERE PICKED UP BY RPF PROM KING PAISAL HOSPITAL AT HIGHT, THIS WILL BE CONFIRMED LATER.
- (3) RPF HAS INDICATED THAT THEY DO NOT SEE THE NECESSITY OF PROCEEDING WITH THE PLANNED REFUGES CAMPIN: THE AREA OF THE GOLF COURSE. THEY INDICATED THATTHEY PLAN TO TAKE INTO CUSTODY THOSE ARE CONVINCED ARE CRIMINALS AND ORDER THE REHAINDER TO GO BACK TO THEIR RESIDENCES.
- B. HUHANITARIAH ASBISTANCE MFP HAS REPORTED THAT THE RPF HAVE STOLEN 8 OF 13 TRUCKS THEY HAD STORED IN THE KIGALI INDUSTRIAL AREA. THEY ALSO REPORT THAT THE RPF HAVE DENIED THEM ACCESS TO TWO OF THEIR WAREHOUSES.

- (1) A HEETING WAS HELD WITH THE UN AND NGO REPRESENTATIVES BY HR PETRIE TO DISCUSS HUMANITARIAN OPERATIONS AND COORDINATION OF EFFORTS OF THE AGENCIES.
