## 3. BEGIN TEXT:

THE SECURITY COUNCIL HAS CONSIDERED THE SECRETARY-GENERAL'S PROGRESS REPORT ON THE UNITED NATIONS ASSISTANCE MISSION FOR RWANDA (UNAMIR) (S/1994/1133).
