PARTICIPANTS AND ALLOWING THE FRENCH MISSION'S MILAD (COL BASTIEN) TO DELIVER A BRIEF STATEMENT ON OPERATION TURQUOISE. BASTIEN NOTED THAT THE FRENCH HAD STABILIZED THE SECTOR AND THAT OVER 400 TONS OF FOOD HAVE BEEN DELIVERED TO DATE. HE OUTLINED THE MEASURES THAT THE FRENCH ARE ENFORCING IN THEIR AREA INCLUDING:

- - ALL FORCES (RGF, RPF, AND ALL MILITIA) MUST
- REFRAIN FROM ALL MILITARY ACTION IN THE ZONE.

- - THE RPF MAY NOT PENETRATE THE ZONE; IF RPF
- FORCES WERE IN THE ZONE AT THE TIME OF THE
- FRENCH DECLARATION THEN THEY MAY STAY BUT MUST
- REFRAIN FROM MILITARY ACTION.
- - ONLY FOOD AND WATER MAY CROSS THE ZONE'S
- PERIMETER.

BASTIEN EMPHASIZED THAT THE RGF AND RPF HAVE AGREED FRENCH FORCES ARE NOT SUPPORTING A PARTICULAR SIDE, AND THAT THE SEAT OF THE GOVERNMENT AND MOST OF THE RGF TROOPS ARE LOCATED OUTSIDE THE ZONE IN THE NORTHEAST PART OF THE COUNTRY. BASTIEN APPEALED TO ALL MEMBER STATES TO ASSIST IN SUPPORTING A REINFORCED UNAMIR. HE CONTINUED STATING THAT THE FRENCH WILL BE OUT NO LATER THAN AUGUST (MANDATE PER RESOLUTION 929 STIPULATES 2 MONTHS) BUT ARE HOPING TO BE OUT MUCH SOONER (READ: END OF JULY).

ANNAN CLOSED BY SAYING THAT RPF CONTACTS WITH THE SPECIAL REPRESENTATIVE, THE FORCE COMMANDER,

AND THE FRENCH WERE COOPERATIVE. GNEHM
