- SUMMARY: THE SECURITY COUNCIL DISCUSSED IN INFORMALS JUNE 14 A DRAFT RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A COMMISSION OF EXPERTS TO LOOK INTO VIOLATIONS OF HUMANITARIAN LAW AND THE GENOCIDE CONVENTION. DELEGATIONS ASKED FOR MORE TIME TO REVIEW THE DRAFT BEFORE COMMENTING, INCLUDING THE U.S., BRAZIL AND THE NAM CAUCUS. NIGERIA WAS THE ONLY MEMBER TO SIGNAL AN OBJECTION TO THE DRAFT, CLAIMING THAT THE FIGHTING SHOULD STOP BEFORE THIS ISSUE WAS DEALT WITH. (THE AUTHOR OF THE DRAFT) POINTED OUT THAT THE PASSAGE OF TIME ALLOWED THE CULPRITS AND THE WITNESS TO EITHER LEAVE THE COUNTRY OR BE KILLED, MAKING IT HARDER TO COMPILE ACCURATE AND COMPLETE INFORMATION.
